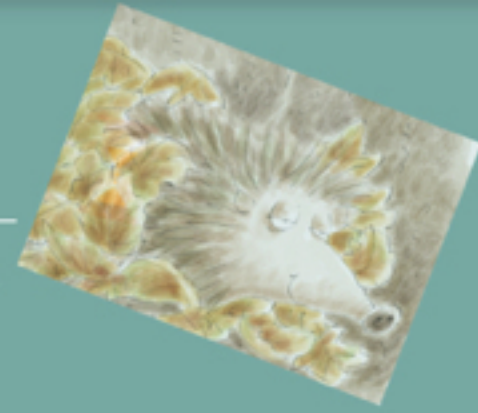
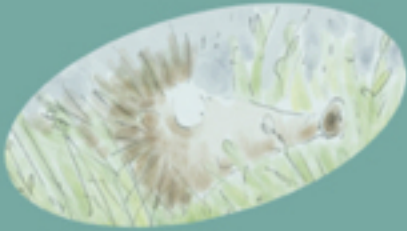


Checklist



How to attract Spikey and other hedgehogs to your garden

Shelter

Hedgehog house

Provide Spikey with a shelter by creating wild areas of dead leaves and rotten wood where he can be warm and safe.
(You could also build him a hedgehog house.)



Food

Hungry

Prepare hedgehog food or meat-based cat/dog food that is either wet (tinned or sachets) or dry (biscuits); Spikey is always hungry!



Pond

Ramp

If you have a pond, provide a little ramp so that if he falls in, he can get out of the water and won't drown.



Rubbish

Keep tidy

Keep the garden tidy and make sure it has no rubbish in it, so that Spikey's nose can't get stuck in anything.



Tunnel

Neighbour's garden

Make a tunnel that he can use from your garden to a neighbour's garden, as he loves to wander for long distances.



Water

Thirsty

Leave a shallow dish of water out too, as he does get thirsty often.



Slug pellets

Poison

Remove all slug pellets – these are poisonous to hedgehogs!
